AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, ADOPTING AND ENACTING AMERICAN LEGAL PUBLISHING'S OHIO BASIC CODE, 2021 EDITION, AS THE CODE OF ORDINANCE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SABINA, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the present general and permanent Ordinances of the Municipality are inadequately arranged and classified and are insufficient in form and substance for the complete preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality and for the proper conduct of its affairs.

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation publishes a Code of Ordinances suitable for adoption by Municipalities in Ohio.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the Municipality for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SABINA, OHIO BY 3/4 VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS OF COUNCIL THAT:

Section 1. American Legal Publishing's Ohio Basic Code, 2021 Edition, as reviewed and approved by the Legislative Authority, is hereby adopted and enacted. Any prior version of the Ohio Basic Code which may have been previously adopted by the Municipality is hereby repealed as obsolete and is hereby replaced in its entirety by this Ohio Basic Code, 2021 Edition.

Section 2. One copy of American Legal Publishing's Ohio Basic Code, 2021 Edition, certified as correct by the Mayor and Clerk of the Legislative Authority, as required by Revised Code § 731.23, shall be kept in its initial form on file in the office of the Clerk of the Municipality and retained as a permanent ordinance record of the Municipality. The Clerk of the Municipality is authorized and directed to publish a summary of all new matters contained in the Code of Ordinances as required by Ohio Revised Code § 731.23. Such summary is attached hereto and marked as "Exhibit A".

Section 3. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of the Ohio Basic Code, 2021 Edition, as adopted in Section hereof, are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance, except as follows:

(A) The enactment of the Ohio Basic Code, 2021 Edition, shall not be construe to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for e enforcement of such right or liability.
