ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PART-TIME UTILITY DEPARTMENT OVERTIME WAGES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Sabina desires to pay part-time utility employees wages at time and one half when said employees are called in to work after regular business hours or on weekends.

WHEREAS, the regular business hours of the Utility Department are Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m.

WHEREAS, this time and a half pay for part time workers shall specifically exclude the pool employees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTHS OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Fiscal Officer is authorized to pay part-time employees of the Utility Department (excluding pool employees) wages at time and one half when said employees are called in to work after regular business hours or on weekends as authorized by the Village Administrator and approved by the Mayor.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure and shall be effective upon passage. The emergency exists so the part-time employees' overtime pay is properly legislated.
