

Ordinance No. 2011-14

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Ohio, three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1. To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Sabina during the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2011, the following sums be and are hereby set aside and additionally appropriated as follows, viz:

Pool Fund

Program: 5501-340 \$3,000.00

Section 2. And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payment from any of the foregoing operations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of an in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the authority to expend money must be in place for pool operations during the pool season.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately,
