

Ordinance No. 2011-25

Passed December 22, 11, 2011

AN ORDINANCE TO REDUCE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011, and declaring an emergency

WHEREAS, The Law Enforcement Trust Drug fund and the Pool fund revenues fell short of the beginning of year estimates and the appropriations were based on spending the anticipated monies; and,

WHEREAS, The Phase II, School Pump Station and Phase III Sewer Rehabilitation Projects are at a point currently under the costs originally budgeted for 2011 as the balance of the design and all of the construction work will be budgeted and completed in 2012 and 2013; and,

WHEREAS, It is necessary and suitable to reduce the appropriations in these funds; and,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Ohio, three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1. Appropriations to funds shall be adjusted to the amounts shown as follows:

Section 2. This ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to have the appropriations reduced to the adjusted amounts prior to end of year.


