

Ordinance No. 2013-8 Passed April 12, 20 13 .

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE WAGES OF ADAM DAY AND JAMES SMITHSON, POLICE STAFF OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, COUNTY OF CLINTON AND STATE OF OHIO, REPEALING ALL PARTS OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to increase the wages of police officers Adam Day and James Smithson;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: That the hourly compensation levels of Adam Day and James Smithson are set for the pay period that begins on April 21, 2013 as follows:

Patrolman, Adam Day \$14.99 per hour
Patrolman, James Smithson \$14.74 per hour

Section 2: This ordinance be declared an emergency measure and becomes effective upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor, to insure for the public, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village of Sabina. The reason for such emergency is to fairly compensate the officers for the work they are performing without delay so as not to lose experienced officers and interrupt Police Department operations.



Ordinance No. 2013-6 Passed March 11th 2013, 20

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING AND CHANGING THE SALARIES OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA,
CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO:

Section One: The pay of the Members of Council shall be \$100.00 per regular scheduled meetings.

Section Two: The pay of the President of Council shall be \$125.00 per regular scheduled meetings.

Section Three: The salary of the Mayor of the Village shall be \$175.00 per regular scheduled meetings.

Section Four: This shall not go into effect until the next Public Election of newly elected officials taking office January 1, 2014. All members who are not up for re-election at the end of 2013 will not be eligible for increase to salary, until current term served has subsided and re-election is scheduled for the year of 2015-16.
