**AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE POSITION OF FULL-TIME PATROLMAN FOR OFFICER JOHN GILBERT FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** Officer John Gilbert's employment as a full-time patrolman with the Village of Sabina shall begin with the pay period of October 5th 2014.

**Section 2:** The hourly compensation of Officer Gilbert shall start at the rate of \$12.98 per hour.

**Section 3:** The Village of Sabina Full-time benefit package shall be applicable for Insurance, paid Holidays of 72 hours, Rate for worked Holiday time, Vacation time, Personal time of 24 hours, accrual of Sick time and enrollment with OP & F Pension Plan.

**Section 4:** All regulations for the probationary period shall be enforced.

**Section 5:** This Ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to fairly compensate the Officer at the beginning of his promotion to the Village.


**Whereas, this Ordinance** shall take effect immediately upon passage.


