

AN ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER MONEY FROM UNEXPENDED FUNDS FOR MORE THAN ONE YEAR OF ACTIVITY AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO, with three-fourths or the majority of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to transfer unspent balances of the following funds to the appropriate like funds.
