Ordinance No. #2018-08 Passed March 8, , 20 2018

AN ORDINANCE TO APPOINT A CANDIDATE TO THE POSITION OF VILLAGE SOLICITOR/PROSECUTOR FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY OHIO. FOR A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR, AND TO FIX THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID AND DECLARE AS AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is the Village's desire to appoint Attorney Lindsey M. Fleissner as the Village Solicitor/ Prosecutor for the Village of Sabina, Ohio, for a term of one (1) year effective the 8th day of March 2018.

WHEREAS, the Village Council now enters into an agreement to provide legal service to the Village Council.

NOW, THEREFORE. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA. CLINTON COUNTY. OHIO, THREE-FOURTH'S (3/4) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

- 1. Lindsey M. Fleissner shall serve as Solicitor for the Village and Prosecuting Attorney as provided by Village Council.**
- 2. The Village shall pay an annual salary of \$9600.00 at \$800.00 per month.**
- 3. General direction on administrative matters shall be given to Ms. Fleissner through the Mayor and or Council or his/her designee. Ms. Fleissner will perform only such legal activities for the Village as are authorized by the Village Council, the Village Administrator, the Village Fiscal Officer of Council or their designees. Ms. Fleissner shall also be authorized to perform, without specific instruction, those legal functions which are necessary or desirable for the welfare of the Village.**
- 4. This Agreement contains all the covenants and agreements between the parties with respect to such employment in any manner whatsoever.**
- 5. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio and the Council for the Village of Sabina, Clinton County Ohio.**

In witness whereof, the parties have executed this Agreement effective the date first stated above.

6.) This agreement shall be in effect for a period of twelve (12) months, commencing March 8, 2018 and ending March 7, 2019.
