	SECTION 1: The Police Chief has the authority to select candidates for vacant positions for employment under the rules as established by the Village.			
	SECTHON 2 : This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare The reason for such necessity is that the Village can not operate properly with the loss of Police Officer coverage as needed on a daily basis. Therefore this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
