AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING AN INCREASE OF HOURLY WAGE FOR POLICE OFFICER ADAM CLARK FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths (3/4) or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**Section 1**: Adam Clark's completion of probationary period as of June 6th, 2020 with the Village of Sabina and proposed successful by Supervisor Keynon Young,

**Section 2**: The hourly compensation of Mr. Clark's for the position of Police Officer shall be at 7% increase in salary, equal to the rate of \$14.45 per hour.

**Section 3:** All regulations for the probationary period were enforced.

**Section 4:** The Ordinance shall declare an Emergency Measure due to fairly compensate Mr. Clark for his service at the beginning of his Anniversary date with the Village.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and the increase shall commence on the June 6th, 2020 pay period.
