**AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY LOCATED ON THE CORNER OF WEST ELM AND NORTH COLLEGE AND ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNERS AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE,**

**WHEREAS**, Robert Wilson approached the Mayor requesting Village Council consider vacating the alley located on the corner of W. Elm Street and N. College Street;

**WHEREAS**, said alley has not been in use for public access for a great number of years and is not maintained by the Village of Sabina;

**WHEREAS**, there are no public utilities pertaining to the alley;

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of Village Council there is good cause for vacating said alley and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest of the Village;

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Clinton County, Ohio, by three fourths of all of the members of the Legislative Authority concurring;

Section One: The alley running between the property of Robert Wilson, Parcel #250060506000300 and the rear of the properties of Roger Littleton, Parcel #250060506000400 and Joseph Kingery, Parcel #250060506000200 and Connie Ewing, Parcel #25006050600100 of the Village of Sabina, is hereby vacated from public use.

Section Two: Robert Wilson agrees to pay all filing fees associated with vacating the alley.

Section Three: The fiscal officer shall cause a certified copy of this ordinance to be recorded in the office of the Clinton County, Recorder


This Ordinance shall be passed as an Emergency due to the health, safety and welfare of the Village residents.
