Mayor, James Mongold, presiding, called the meeting in session on Thursday, November 12th, 2020 at 7:00 o'clock p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mrs. Grehl and the Prayer was led by Mayor Mongold. Members present were Mrs. Mongold, Mr. Collings, Mr. Arnold, Ms. Sloan, Mr. Gottschalk and Mrs. Grehl. Roll-call was taken by the Fiscal Officer Nancy Cornell with all members present. At this time the Mayor stated the meeting had a quorum and declared in session.

MINUTES: Mayor Mongold asked if everyone had the chance to read the minutes of October 22nd and if there are not any changes or concerns to be made, he will ask for a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Collings then made the motion to approve the minutes and was seconded by Mrs. Grehl. Roll call was taken and all members were in favor.

PERSONS INVITED BY THE MAYOR: None present at this time.

MAYORS REPORT: Mayor Mongold stated "In the last week, I've been working with Sabina Area Business Association President, Stefanie McFadden to compile a list of items that may be needed by area businesses over the next three to six months. The Village, with Council's approval, can purchase these things and donate them to Village businesses and organizations utilizing C.A.R.E.S. Act funds.

I can think of no better cause. Right now, our businesses and organizations are struggling. With Covid-19 into round two and the cold and flu season upon us, we must find ways to support them. I urge every member of Council to focus on this over the next few months. This is a challenge we must meet. Without the strength of our businesses and organizations, the Village itself suffers. When that happens, every one of us living here is affected.

So far, regardless of the ill winds that have blown across not only our Village, but everywhere, Sabina has seen improvement. That improvement will have been for nothing if we start losing the businesses and organizations that support us and the people. We cannot sustain when these start going away.

To the people of the Village, I urge you to shop and buy local when you are able. Many area businesses offer gift certificates. They make excellent gifts. If you are looking to donate, donate to local organizations. Food pantries are going to need help this year. With everything else going on, we are also heading into the holiday season. No one should go without ever, but this time of year we need to come together and help those around us.

We all have the power to make our Village, our home, a better place. I ask that, if you are able, if you have time, you step up and do what you can. Together we do make a difference. We can reduce the problems. We can support local. We can rise to the challenge. It will take courage, perseverance, and determination, but so far we've been doing good working together. Now, we need to show everyone, in these worsening times, what great is."

Mayor Mongold stated that Stephanie and himself are getting PPE requests returned from local businesses with what they need. Mayor Mongold requested Councils approval to set aside \$20,000 to help supply local businesses with needed supplies. Mr. Collings made the motion to set aside \$20,000 to support local businesses and the motion was seconded by Ms. Sloan. Roll call was taken with an "All in Favor". Mayor Mongold then asked when Council would like to reschedule the Thanksgiving and Christmas meetings since they fall of the holidays. move the next Council meeting from December 24th to December 21st and the motion was seconded by Mr. Collings. Roll call was taken with an "All in Favor".

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR: Mr. Dean asked with all of the COVID-19 in our community, if an employee calls in sick one day if they should be tested before they come back? Mr. Arnold stated to ask the Health Department what they suggest. Mr. Dean has been working on updating our emergency plan. Additionally, Mr. Dean stated that he does not think the water tower will be done this year due to the weather. Lastly, Bryan Floyd will be return to work next week after being quarantined due to COVID-19.

CHIEF: Chief Grehl stated that there have been 2300 calls for service as of today and there have been 389 case reports. Chief Grehl said last Friday there was a truck that got lost in town and tore down some electric lines and the power box at Flagway. Additionally, the Police Department is having issues getting the 2016 cruiser in to stall the lights and striping. Lastly, the officers will be going back to 12 hour shifts and Sydney will be working with Justin during the night shift.

LAW DIRECTOR: Mrs. Gibson stated that she had nothing to report.

FISCAL OFFICER: Ms. Cornell stated that she balanced October's bank but there were a couple snags that have been sorted out. Ms. Cornell explained how much money we have approximately spent from the CARES Act Funds. Ms. Cornell reported on the bill list in the amount of \$90,160.70. No expenses to the Village in the amount of \$18,213.18. This left the expense to the village \$71,947.52. She explained the large items to Council in the amount of \$67,662.49 and this left miscellaneous expense at \$4,285.03. She asks for comments regarding concerns or any items that needed explained. No one had any issues so a motion was asked for to pay the bills. The motion came from Ms. Sloan and a second by Mrs. Grehl. Roll call was taken with an "All in Favor".
